
MARKERS, INC. SmartPole™ Hook'n'Hang Outfield Fence



YOU MAY ALSO NEED THE FOLLOWING TOOLS:

Tape Measure • String • Chalk or Spray Paint • Mallet or Drill • Sharp Scissors (if cutting is required)

A - Lay out fence line

Using tape measure lay out the radius. Chalk or paint the line where fence will be installed.


B - Mark pole locations



Starting at foul line, mark 19 pole locations approx. 8.5 ft. apart **for each 160 ft. set**. Note: If using multiple sets, mark end locations close together between each set. You can allow for openings 2 ft. wide between sets for a gateway, or keep them close for a fence with no gateway. (see 3 diagrams below)





480 ft., 57 poles (8.5 ft spacing)

Use 15 reinforced poles as shown (o)


100 ft. to Home Plate

160 ft., 19 poles (8.5 ft spacing)

Use 5 reinforced poles as shown (O)
